### ***Not Sure When to Call TPD?***

Do call:

- If a salesperson comes to the door but has no identification card, or will not give you the company's phone number and name, or doesn't even have any product with them, or even worse, won't leave when you tell them to.
- If you see a man, woman, or child walking down the street looking around, acting suspicious, or circling or walking up and down the street, or circling on a bike.
- If you see someone walking in the alleys looking around.

Don't call:

- If you see someone walking normally down the street.
- If you see your neighbor who always takes an evening walk.

When in doubt, call 911.
