REFRESHING OUR MEMORY:

We live in the "City of Tucson" and in doing so there are City codes that need to be followed. Listed below are some that all of us need to remember.

1. **ACCUMULATION OF REFUSE (GARBAGE) PROHIBITED:** Any lawn grass and all weeds that exceeds six (6) inches in height.
2. **ILLEGAL, LITTERING OR DUMPING PROHIBITED.**
3. **JUNK, LITTER AND DEBRIS:** Accumulation of junk, litter and debris cannot be left in the yard. It must be disposed of properly. This includes junk auto parts, appliances, furniture, building and/or landscaping material, and tires: litter such as discarded paper, cardboard, plastics, etc; debris such as tree trimmings and fallen tree limbs: or any other items that have been discarded.

We all have our pets and we love them, but there is a code saying that when walking pets you must "pick up" after them. This means doing a "poop-scooper" operation. Leaving this debris in the area between the street and sidewalk is very unsightly.

The fire season is upon us and the dry grass and weeds shouldn't be allowed to remain uncut. This accumulation is very dangerous. Our neighborhood could be destroyed by fire if they are allowed to remain.

As a people, let us be considerate of all of our neighbors and our neighborhood. Watch our speeding on the roadways, keep our yards clean and neat, do not take items that you want to get rid of and put them on someone else's property that is vacant, working on cars, storing of junk and inoperable motor vehicles. If we are willing to act on the above, our neighborhood will be better for it.
