On Tuesday September 29th the Naylor Neighborhood will vote on the final plans for the mostly empty lot at Swan Park. We hope you can make it to this meeting. The meeting will be at 6:00 PM at Eckstrom-Columbus Library. The plans will be part of the grant proposal submitted to Pima County Neighborhood Reinvestment fund. The grant will transform the lot into a park that includes the new playground. Some components of the design include shade structures near the playground, a water fountain, a post and cable system to keep cars away from the playground, a bridge that crosses the wash, a walking path, additional trees, etc.

This is in addition to some of the improvements that Parks & Recreation will install in the next 6 months. Those improvements include a shade structure that goes over the playground, a climbing boulder, seating around the playground, and an ADA accessible sidewalk.

We have a new Neighborhood President Jim Beard. At this next meeting, we hope to vote in a Vice President and a Secretary. Now's a good time to get involved. Great things are happening in our neighborhood.
