What is the neighborhood cleanup?

On **November 8th** neighbors will be getting together throughout the community to work on cleaning up areas of the neighborhood that are weedy and littered.

The City of Tucson will be dropping off four 40-yard roll off dumpsters in the neighborhood area.

These dumpsters are there for you to throw away any non-hazardous garbage and debris that you may have accumulated at your home or yard. This is a great opportunity to clean up the yard and throw out the old junk that you were thinking about taking to the dump.

The dumpsters will be located at:

Escalante and Harrison-on the corner east of Harrison and just South of Escalante

Myra and Harrison-on the corner just South of Myra and East of Harrison

On Portia Avenue-between Watson and Irene

On Bonanza Avenue-between Watson and Stella

This is being scheduled between our **Brush and Bulky** pick up dates so that we can take full advantage of the opportunity to clean up our neighborhood.
