ARTICLE V. SIGN TYPES AND GENERAL REGULATIONS

Sec. 3-67. Temporary signs.

...

C. Grand opening, sales and civic events banner, general requirements:

1. Banners:

- a. All corners of the banner must be attached to the building wall or façade. No banner can be placed on any rooftop above the roofline, attached or detached in any manner, or on poles, trees, or automobiles.
- b. Maximum number: 1 per street frontage.
- c. Maximum area: 90 45 square feet, for buildings of up to 90 linear feet of building elevation, 90 square feet for buildings over 90 linear feet of building elevation.
- d. A permit for the use of a banner will be issued for up to forty-five days. Banners cannot be used for more than a cumulative total of ninety (90) days in any calendar year.
- e. Removal. A The banner must be removed after forty five consecutive days.
- f. Location: The banner cannot be placed in a location on the building that covers emergency egress routes, public access ways, or windows or doorways that are required for compliance with public safety regulations, the Land Use Code, or any other City ordinance.
- g. Banners must be one continuous piece of material, not a connection or accumulation of smaller banners attached together.
