Fire Department discussion /Chemicals Insert</p> <p>Deputy Chief Dan Uthe and Assistant Chief Ray Allen from the Tucson Fire Department reviewed with the Subcommittee the discontinued requirement for all businesses to fill out a hazardous material inventory sheet during the business license process for tracking purposes.</p> <p>A Chemical Fire Response Coordination Task Force (created by SB 1112 found in ARS 26-343) has been created which requires the Task Force to establish a tracking program (that would be consistent state-wide) that identifies the buildings/businesses that store or use hazardous materials.</p> <p>The Task Force has not identified the program for tracking as of yet, but will recommend using the framework of the Tier II reporting system which can be accessed via a website. There will be a cost associated to a state-wide reporting program and or to upgrade the existing Tier II reporting software.</p> <p>The Legislature has requested that the Task Force have recommendations submitted on or before December, 2009. The Chemical Fire Response Coordination Task Force will forward their recommendations accordingly.</p>	<p>Tucson Fire Department responsible</p>
