


DECLARATION OF ANNE DORIS



DECLARATION OF DANIEL POTTENGER

1. My name is Daniel Pottenger and I am a Tax Manager for CoxCom, Inc. ("Cox")
2. In performing my duties for Cox, I responded to inquiries made by Ashpaugh & Sculco, PLC, in connection with their Cable Television License Fee and PEG Fee Analysis of Cox Communications for the City of Tucson (the "City"), Arizona. I therefore am familiar with the factual issues presented by the City's allegation that CoxCom, Inc. d/b/a Cox Communications Tucson failed to pay the City the full amount of license fees owed for the period October 1, 2000 through September 30, 2005. Due to my knowledge of the circumstances of this dispute, I reviewed the "License Fee Audit Analysis" attached as Exhibit C to the foregoing Proposal for Renewal Cable License (the "Cox Proposal").

I also am familiar with the various license fees and taxes that Cox remits to the City pursuant to Cox's cable television License Agreement, and prepared estimates of future fees and taxes that Cox may be required to pay under provisions outlined in the City's Request for Proposal for Renewal Cable License adopted January 17, 2007. 

DECLARATION OF CHRISTOPHER A. BAKER

1. My name is Christopher A. Baker and I am a Senior Research Associate at Marketing Intelligence, LLC, a marketing research and strategy consulting firm located in Tucson, Arizona (“Marketing Intelligence”).
2. I was retained by CoxCom, Inc. d/b/a Cox Communications Tucson (“Cox”) to research public opinion regarding the cable television needs, interests, and preferences of Tucson residents in connection with the renewal of Cox’ s license to provide cable services in the City of Tucson.
3. As part of my work for Cox, I oversaw the preparation of the document entitled “Summary of Research Findings: Report of Findings and Analysis” dated November 17, 2006, and attached to Cox ’ s Proposal for Renewal Cable License (the “Cox Proposal”) as Exhibit B (the “Cox Survey”).
4. The Cox Survey contains both primary and secondary consumer research data compiled by Marketing Intelligence and Zimmerman and Associates regarding the cable-related needs and interests of Cox ’ s current and potential video service customers in the Tucson market. The Cox Survey also includes an analysis of that data, which accurately reflects my professional judgment about the meaning of the consumer research data compiled therein.

6. I declare under penalty of perjury that the facts contained in the Cox Survey and the underlying data on which the Cox Survey is based, as well as the facts contained herein are true and correct to the best of my knowledge, information, and belief formed after reasonable inquiry.
