VISIT THE LOCATION NEAREST YOU!



1. Tangerine Landfill (7:30 a.m. to 4:45 p.m. every day)
2. Marana Airport, west of entrance (follow signs)
3. Oro Valley lot, "Naranja Town site," 660 W. Naranja, 229-5070
4. Pima County Ina Road Landfill, west of I-10 (8 a.m. to 4:45 p.m. Mon. - Fri.)
5. Rillito Race Track, east parking lot (follow signs)
6. Udall Park, south of Little League ball fields (follow signs)
7. Golf Links Sports Park, northwest of Craycroft Rd. and Golf Links Rd.
8. Rodeo Grounds, north of Irvington Rd. by east parking lot entrance
9. Davis-Monthan AFB, recycling center (base access required)
10. Los Reales Landfill (follow Treecycle signs)
11. Cross Point Community Church, 7901 S. Rita Rd. (follow signs)
12. Sahuarita Landfill (7:30 a.m. to 4:45 p.m., Thurs. thru Sun. ONLY)

Note:

All City of Tucson sites will close at sundown, Monday, January 13, 2008

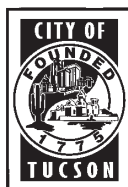
IMPORTANT:

- The City of Tucson will not collect Christmas trees from curbs and alleys.
- TreeCycle sites cannot accept other green waste. Commercial tree lot overages are not accepted at TreeCycle sites, except for Los Reales Landfill & Tangerine Landfill, at posted landfill rate.
- Tree Pool! Bring your neighbor's tree - fewer trips mean cleaner air
