Toilet Rebate



Tucson Water's Residential Toilet Rebate Program

The Toilet Rebate Program is for all Tucson Water customers with a toilet that was manufactured prior to 1991 and uses 3.5 gallons/flush or more.

Tucson Water is committed to helping our customers become more water efficient, both indoors and outdoors. Toilet flushing represents one of the largest uses of water inside a typical home, accounting for more than 25% of indoor daily use. Replacing older toilets with high-efficiency models is a cost-effective way to conserve our precious water supplies.

Tucson Water is offering a Toilet Rebate program to encourage and assist our customers who wish to purchase and install new, more efficient toilet fixtures. In order to ensure that the new fixtures both save water and work effectively, Tucson Water is partnering with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) WaterSense Program, a national water efficiency certification program.

The Toilet Rebate Program is available to all Tucson Water customers who currently have a toilet that was manufactured prior to 1991 and uses 3.5 gallons/flush or more. Customers must meet the following standards in order to qualify for the Rebate program:

- Only fixtures purchased after July 7, 2008 qualify for a rebate.
- Toilets must be installed on properties receiving water from **Tucson Water**.
- Rebate amount is limited to **50% of purchase price with a maximum of \$120 per toilet**. A maximum rebate of \$200 per household is allowed if multiple toilets are installed. The rebate covers only the purchase cost of the tank and bowl, and does not include tax or additional supplies.
- Only High Efficiency Toilet (HET) fixtures approved by the USEPA WaterSense program qualify for rebate. **An HET fixture uses 1.3 gallons per flush or less.**

Rebate amount is limited to 50% of purchase price with a maximum of \$120 per toilet.

- Rebates are provided to encourage the voluntary early replacement of

older, less efficient **pre-1991 toilets**. Fixtures replaced as part of a general construction permit (such as a house remodeling) do not qualify for rebate.

- Fixture must replace a **3.5 gallon per flush or greater volume toilet**
- Old toilet fixtures must not be used again, and must be rendered inoperable.
- Participants in the rebate program must consent to an inspection of the property to verify purchase and
