**ARTICLE I
NAME**

The name of this association shall be Blue Moon Neighborhood Association.



**ARTICLE II
OBJECT**

The object of this association shall be to preserve Blue Moon Neighborhood as a safe, clean, and sound historical neighborhood; to provide a healthy environment for children to grow up in, for adults to enjoy, and for area businesses to thrive; and to preserve a geographical "home" that all residents can take pride in.

**ARTICLE III
MEMBERS**

Section 1. The membership of this association is open to any property owner or renter who is a resident of the Blue Moon Neighborhood; and to any commercial "resident" who's business is within the geographic bounds of said neighborhood.

Section 2. There shall be no monetary dues for membership in the Blue Moon Neighborhood Association.

Section 3. Residents interested in becoming members shall simply express their interest and enter their name, address, and phone number in the membership log at a monthly meeting.

**ARTICLE IV
OFFICERS**

Section 1. The officers of this association shall be a President, a Vice President, a Secretary, and a Treasurer. Refer to exhibit A for respective duties of each officer.

Section 2. Officers shall be elected by majority vote at the annual meeting and shall serve a term of one year, or until their successor has been elected. The one-year term shall begin at the close of the annual meeting.

**ARTICLE V
MEETINGS**

Section 1. The regular meetings of the Association shall be monthly meetings held on the third Friday of each month. If a meeting date needs to be changed due to unexpected events, members shall be notified by telephone, in writing, or in person at least one week in advance.

Section 2. The monthly meeting held in September shall be the Annual meeting during which election of Officers takes place.

Section 3. Special or emergency meetings may be called if necessary, and business held during such a meeting shall be considered official if a quorum of at least 10 members are present at the meeting.

**ARTICLE VI
COMMITTEES**

Section 1. Committees will be formed on a volunteer, as-needed basis, and will be temporary unless voted permanent by a majority vote. Committees will be determined to be 'as-needed' during regular business at the monthly meetings and will be formed at the same meeting.

Section 2. If a committee is deemed necessary to be permanent, nominations and voting shall occur at the following monthly meeting.

**ARTICLE VII
PARLIAMENTARY AUTHORITY**

The rules contained in the current edition of Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised shall govern the Association in all cases to which they are applicable and in which they are not inconsistent with these bylaws or any special rules of order the Association may adopt.

**ARTICLE VIII
AMENDMENT OF BYLAWS**

These bylaws may be amended at any monthly meeting of the Association by a majority vote, provided that the amendment has been submitted in writing at the previous meeting.

EXHIBIT A

OFFICERS DUTIES

The PRESIDENT shall call and preside at all meetings, shall act for and in behalf of the membership of the association, shall act as official spokesperson for the association, and shall decide when permanent committees need to be formed.

The VICE PRESIDENT shall, in the absence of the President assume all of the duties of that office and shall be responsible for publicity and notification of meetings of the association.

The SECRETARY shall keep a permanent record of all formal meetings and all legal documents and legal transactions of the association. The Secretary shall transcribe the minutes of each meeting, maintaining a file copy and submitting a copy to the CNS.

The TREASURER shall keep all financial receipts and a permanent record of all the financial business of the association. An up-to-date financial report shall be submitted at each meeting. The Treasurer shall be responsible for membership.

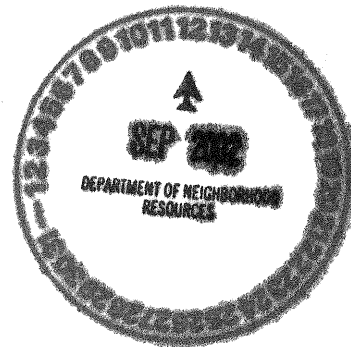
AMENDMENTS TO THE BYLAWS

ARTICLE III

Members

Section 4. Any person who resides outside the neighborhood boundaries and who has an interest in seeking to improve Barrio Blue Moon can become a member and will be entitled to run for office. People interested in becoming a member shall be given an opportunity to explain why they would like to join, during a regular neighborhood meeting. At which time the majority of members in attendance shall vote to accept or deny their membership.
