

RILLITOBEND NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION

ARTICLE I – NAME

The name of this organization shall be RillitoBend Neighborhood Association.

ARTICLE II – PURPOSE

The purpose of this organization shall be to protect and maintain the existing rural, residential character of the neighborhood, with special attention to the betterment of the social, physical and economic life of the citizens of the RillitoBend area of the City of Tucson.

ARTICLE III – BOUNDARIES AND MEMBERSHIP

The RillitoBend Neighborhood Association area shall be bounded by Campbell Avenue to Roger Road, on the north by Roger Road to the Jackson Road Extension, north to the Rillito River, following the Rillito River north, east, and south to Prince Road, thence west on Prince Road to Campbell.

The membership of the organization will consist of all residents 16 years of age or older of the Tucson-Prince area. Non-resident property owners shall be permitted to join the membership at the discretion of the chairman.

ARTICLE IV – BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS

A board of directors, numbering fifteen members in good standing of the association shall constitute the governing board for the association. The board members will be elected for two-year terms of office. The election will be held during the annual business meeting.

The members of the elected board, after the election, will appoint, from among themselves, a chairperson, vice-chairperson, and secretary to serve one year terms.

ARTICLE V – MEETINGS

An annual meeting will be held in the month of October, at a convenient time and place selected by the Chairman. Notice of such meeting will be given to the membership at least seven (7) days prior to the meeting.

Special meetings may be called at the discretion of the Chairman.

ARTICLE VI – CONDUCT OF MEETINGS

All meetings will be conducted in compliance with *Robert's Rules of Order*. These rules may be suspended if, in the opinion of the Chairman, they are not necessary to conduct an orderly meeting.


All speakers will be limited to five minutes on any one subject; at the discretion of the Chairman this rule may be waived.

ARTICLE VII – AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES

These Articles may be amended by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the members at the annual meeting. Notice must be given at least seven (7) days prior to the meeting to propose any change in the Articles.
