

## Charter and Bylaws of the El Rio Neighborhood Association

This neighborhood association is formed to promote a meaningful and lasting relationship among neighbors and to promote the enhancement of the lifestyle found within this neighborhood.

Article 1. Name and Boundaries.

This neighborhood shall be known as El Rio Neighborhood Association. The area served by the El Rio Assoc. is bounded as follows:

North-Grant Rd.

East - I-10


South Speedway Blvd.

West Silvercroft Wash

The place where the principal office of the Association is to be located in the City of Tucson, Pima County, AZ.

### Article II. Purposes

1. To encourage and preserve the community identity and provide a forum for common concerns.
2. To provide a structure for the discussion of neighborhood issues and the development of programs to address these issues.
3. To protect and enhance neighborhood schools, parks, churches and other social and recreational facilities.



## Bylaws

### Article I. Membership.


1. The membership shall be composed of two categories voting member and associate member.
2. A voting member shall be a member who resides or owns real property within the El Rio Neighborhood Association boundaries. A voting member shall be entitled to one vote.
3. An associate member shall be a person, business or organization interested in the progress of this neighborhood and shall not be accorded any voting rights.
4. Those persons under 18 years of age applying for membership shall be associate members.

### Article II. Officers.

1. The officers of this association shall hold office for a term of one year or until their successors are elected. The term of office shall begin at the close of the annual meeting. The duties of the officers shall be as follows:
  - a. The president shall call and preside at all meetings, shall appoint any special committees necessary. The president shall implement decisions of the association.
  - b. The Vice President shall in the absence of the President assume all duties of that office.
  - c. The secretary shall keep a permanent record of all formal meetings and all legal documents and legal transactions of the association.
  - d. The Treasurer shall keep in his possession all receipts and a permanent record all financial business of the association, and submit an up to date financial report at each meeting. The treasurer shall be responsible for membership status.
1. An officer shall not hold more than two consecutive terms in any one office, and no member shall hold more than one office at a time.

### Article III. Committees.

1. Committees shall be: Any committee found necessary by the Neighborhood Association.
2. Committee chairs shall be appointed by a majority vote of the Neighborhood Association.



**Article V.**

1. Withdrawal of any funds this association may have will require at least two signatures of the four officers, one of which must be Treasurer.
2. All withdrawls must have majority approval of the neighborhood association.

**Article VI. Parliamentary Authority**

All meetings shall be governed by Robert's Rules of Order.

**Article VI. Amendment of Bylaws**

1. These Bylaws may be amended in concurrence with and upon recommendation of the neighborhood association by a quorum.
2. Proposed amendments shall be sent to all members of the association at least ten (10) days in advance of the meeting where the action is to be taken.
