## 'Tis the Season to TreeCycle

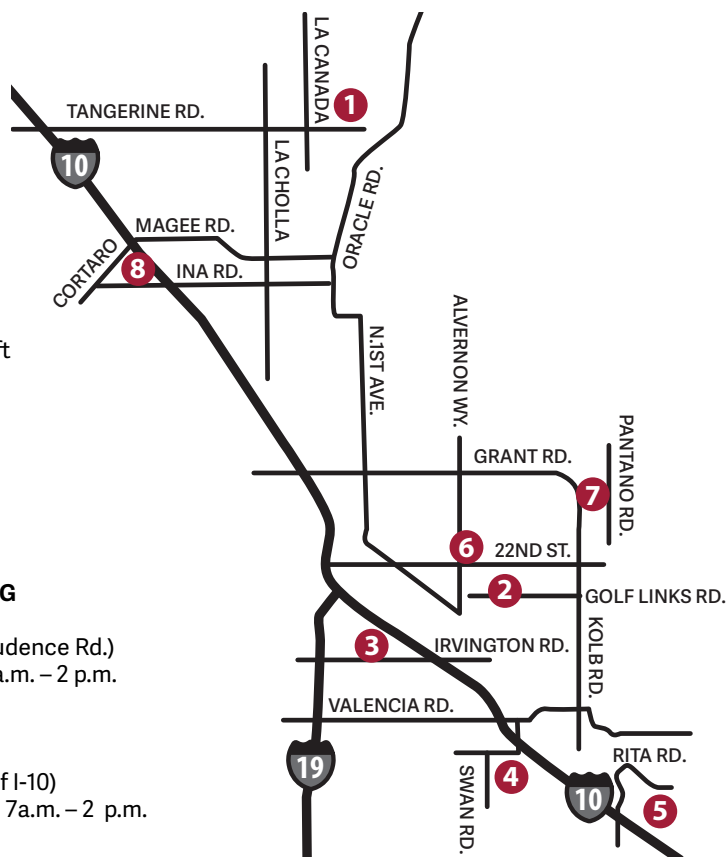
Just **remove everything** from the tree, including the stand, lights, ornaments, wire and tinsel. Then drop it off at one of the **8 TreeCycle sites** located throughout Tucson and Oro Valley. It's that easy. Your tree will be mulched and used for composting.

Mon – Fri, 7 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. Sat, 7 a.m. – 2 p.m.

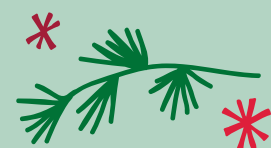


### Important! Please take note

- The City of Tucson will **NOT** collect Christmas trees from curbs and alleys.
- TreeCycle sites cannot accept other green waste. Commercial tree lot overages are **NOT** accepted at TreeCycle sites, except for Los Reales Landfill, at posted landfill rate.
- Please do **NOT** leave trees outside the collection time or area due to fire hazard.
