
City of Tucson Department of Transportation invites you to an open house for the 4th Avenue / Fontana Bicycle Boulevard

PROJECT BACKGROUND

The 4th Avenue/Fontana Bicycle Boulevard Project will provide bicyclists of all abilities a safe and pleasant place to ride in midtown Tucson. The route connects thousands of residents between Prince Road and University Boulevard to shopping, jobs, schools and to several other bicycle friendly routes that easily reach the University of Arizona, downtown and beyond. The plan for the Bicycle Boulevard was developed by the Drachman Institute with input from the neighborhoods along the corridor in 2008.

You are invited to attend any of the scheduled open houses – the focus of each meeting will concentrate on the design elements for that particular segment of the bike boulevard.
