SUBJECT: Final Expenditure Limitations – Public Matching Funds

Pursuant to the provisions of the Tucson Charter Chapter XVI, Subchapter B, pertaining to Campaign Finance Administration expenditure limitations, the **final expenditure limits** for candidates who sign campaign contracts are listed below. These amounts are based upon the Consumer Price Index and the number of registered voters (284,406) residing in the City as of June 30, 2017. The amounts went up due to an increase in the number of registered voters between June 30, 2016 and June 30, 2017.

FINAL EXPENDITURE LIMITS — 2017	COUNCIL MEMBER
Final expenditure amount per voter	\$0.4316
Maximum amount a candidate may spend through the end of the campaign period	\$122,749.63
Maximum amount a candidate may spend through the day of the Primary Election	\$92,062.22
Maximum amount a candidate may receive in public matching funds	\$61,374.81
Maximum amount a candidate may contribute to their own campaign	\$3,682.48

Candidates participating in the Primary Election who sign campaign contracts must file a Statement to Establish Eligibility by August 21, 2017. For those candidates participating in the General Election, the deadline to file a Statement of Eligibility is October 30, 2017. Please contact me if you have any questions regarding this matter.
