Individuals wishing to speak during the public hearing (subject to technological availability) will join the meeting via teleconference. **You must submit a written request to speak to cityclerk@tucsonaz.gov no later than 12:00p.m. on Friday, May 7, 2021.** Your email should include your name and phone number you will use for the teleconference. The phone number will be used to identify the individual when/if being called upon to speak. Once your request to speak has been received by the City Clerk, you will be provided instructions on how to connect to the teleconference.
