





Become an Elections Poll Worker

***Primary Election—September 1st
General Election—November 3rd***



REQUIREMENTS:

- ★ Must be a registered voter residing in the City of Tucson at least 29 days prior to the Primary Election
- ★ Must have transportation to and from the polling place
- ★ Must have legible handwriting

HOURS:

- ★ Election Day report at 5:00 a.m. and stay until approximately 9:00 p.m., or later.

DUTIES:

- ★ If possible, prior to Election day, visit assigned Polling Place to become familiar with the facility
- ★ Prepare polling place for voting
- ★ Conduct voting in the precinct polling place
- ★ Assist voters with the election process
- ★ Close polling place and deliver voted ballots to receiving center

TRAINING:

- ★ Mandatory instruction class 2-3 weeks before each Election. Class will last approximately 1½ hours long.

HOW TO APPLY

Due to a reduction in the number of polling places for the 2009 Elections, there will be a limited number of positions available for hire.
