


RE: 2012 Annual Report – Citizens' Transportation Advisory Committee (CTAC)

CITIZENS' TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE 2012 ANNUAL REPORT

February 6, 2012

Tony Paez, Interim Director of TDOT, gave CTAC members a copy of the 2012 Department of Transportation "State of Our Transportation System." Mr. Paez stated that although the number of employees in the Transportation Department has dropped, citizens still expect the same level of service. Mr. Paez also said that CTAC is a very important committee to the Transportation Department because the committee can assist in educating the public on transportation issues.

Mr. Paez gave a brief update on the Modern Street Car including the current cost estimate of \$55 million to complete. He also talked about upcoming safety enhancements in some areas as well as completed projects.

Vice Chair Sami Hamed appointed Chair Farhad Moghimi to serve on the Broadway Boulevard Citizens' Task Force.

April 2, 2012

The CTAC meeting scheduled for April 2, 2012 was canceled due to lack of a quorum.

June 4, 2012

Maria Gayosso, Plan Tucson Project Manager, and Rebecca Ruopp, Principal Planner gave a presentation on the General Plan Update on Transportation and Land Use Planning. Ms. Gayosso explained that voters approved the present Tucson General Plan in 2001, and that all municipalities must now adopt a new plan that will be good for 10 years. The deadline for this new plan is 2015 and Ms. Gayosso stated that several meetings have already been held with the public and various stakeholders to get their input. Once the plan has been completed, it will be sent to the Mayor and Council.

August 6, 2012

October 1, 2012
