SUBJECT: Tucson Greens Committee – 2014 Annual Report

The Tucson Greens Committee met eleven times in 2014, with the July meeting canceled because a majority of the members could not attend. Three new members were appointed during 2014, Jerry Anderson in June and Andres Ramos and Claudia Valdez in August. Three members came off the committee in 2014, Joe Rodriguez, Frank Salbego and Claudia Valdez.

Tucson Greens Committee meetings focused on the transition of Tucson City Golf to management by OB Sports, which officially took place on February 1, 2014. Most of the meetings included discussion and reports on OB Sports efforts to improve course conditions, improve customer service, upgrade facilities and upgrade equipment. Each month a golf rounds and financial report was provided to the committee.

Reports on the First Tee program and DIVOTS occurred throughout the year. In 2014, DIVOTS volunteers contributed 1,073 hours of service on the golf courses. Based upon the Independent Sector (https://www.independentsector.org/volunteer_time) value of volunteer time in Arizona at \$22.52 per hour, DIVOTS equates to \$24,163.96 of services to the City. This is a valuable volunteer effort that benefits players on Tucson City Golf courses.
