SUBJECT: Tucson Convention Center Commission – 2014 Annual Report

The Tucson Convention Center Commission met ten times in 2014, with the February meeting canceled because of a conflict with the Gem Show and the March meeting canceled because a majority of the members could not attend.

Many of the Tucson Convention Center Commission meetings focused on the arena construction project and the transition of private management of the TCC. Meetings included discussion and reports on the RFP process, the construction process and the new management company, SMG.

Several highlights of the year included a presentation about the Tucson Musicians Museum that will be located at TCC and the TCC Today project to improve a portion of the Eckbo Plaza. In September, the commission drafted a letter supporting Rio Nuevo's request for a variance for the two new monument signs. The variance request was presented to the Sign Codes Advisory and Appeals Board.

The year concluded with a tour of the new arena renovations during the December meeting.
