LEGAL ACTION REPORT

ACTION TAKEN:

A Quorum of the Civil Service Commission, consisting of Chair Max Parks and Commissioners David Flaughter and Malcom Pavey, met on July 27 and 29, 2015, to hear the matter of Brandon Kelly. Commissioner David Flaughter made motion that the appeal of Brandon Kelly be sustained and that he be reinstated to his position of employment with the City of Tucson except for a suspension without back pay for the reason that while there was evidence that Officer Kelly engaged in improper conduct, which the Commission finds that Officer Kelly knew or should have known could lead to disciplinary action, there was not just cause for the discipline which was imposed. Commissioner Malcom Pavey seconded the motion. The vote was 2-1 with Commissioner Parks dissenting.
