A quorum of the Civil Service Commission of the City of Tucson met on Monday, August 31, 2015, for a Special Meeting. This meeting is a continuation of the discussion started at the August 12, 2015 Quarterly Meeting. The meeting was held at City Hall, 255 W. Alameda, 1st Floor Conference Room in Tucson, AZ.
