Minutes

1. Call to Order, Introductions

2. Call to the Audience

3. Review and approval of minutes from last meeting

All voted in favor of approval.

4. Introductions of New Members

Introduction of new committee members: Arlie is a planning professor in the UofA College of Planning, Architecture and Landscape Architecture with expertise in transportation planning. Colby is a neighborhood leader, LSA volunteer and member of the Broadway task force.

5. Review and Discuss Subcommittee Action Plan

Committee members discussed each item on the plan. Through our discussion it was clear that the funding levels and pathways are complex and that we need to have a better understanding in order to advocate for transparency and accountability with respect to what little funding there is. For example, in the PAG survey, residents stated they wanted more money for transit and more money for alternate modes. However, in response, the money for transit is all for maintenance not improvements, and a bulk of the alternate modes money goes to the urban loop which does not serve to get people where they need to go.

Additionally we need to continue to consider dedicated sources of funding- either through a City bond or through an innovative method like the one used in Phoenix. The committee is well-represented on projects and we agreed to continue on this capacity.

6. Current Projects and Programs

Grant Road design is ongoing. John has joined the Grant Road Improvement Project Task Force.

7. RTP Task Force and RTA

Subcommittee will ask Ann to present on RTA funding at the next meeting on October 29th.

Subcommittee will get an update from Arlie and John about PAG bike and ped funding and be prepared to suggest an action at the next PAC meeting on October 14th.
