

2015 Annual Report

For the Tucson Police and Fire Public Safety Personnel Retirement System Local Boards

Pursuant to TCC 10A-139(c), this letter shall constitute the annual report of the Tucson Police and Tucson Fire Public Safety Personnel Retirement System Local Boards for the year 2015.

The Police and Fire Public Safety Personnel Retirement Boards held regular, joint, monthly meetings during 2015. The boards met in all months with a quorum of members. The purpose of the meetings is to provide for administration of the retirement system by determining all questions of eligibility and service credits, determining benefit amounts and the manner and time of payment of any benefit to members of the plan.

The Police board held a special mail ballot election from May 21, to June 12, 2015 due to the retirement of Mr. J. D. Kragnes from the Tucson Police Department. He resigned his seat on the board effective June 30, 2015. His term was to have run through June 30, 2016. The official canvass of the special election results were provided at the July 2015 meeting. Mr. Terrence O'Hara was elected to the Police Board for the remainder of Mr. Kragnes' term.

Mr. Curry Hale resigned his position on the Police and Fire boards effective September 1, 2015 due to his acceptance of employment with the City of Marana. He was a Mayoral appointment to the Police board and Fire board whose term was scheduled to end June 30, 2017. Mayor Rothschild subsequently appointed Ms. Rebecca Hill to fill that position for the remainder of Mr. Hale's term.

Having been reelected Mayor of the City of Tucson in November 2015, Mayor Jonathan Rothschild started at started a second term as Chairman of the Police and Fire Public Safety Personnel Retirement Boards effective December 8, 2015. This term coincides with his new term as Mayor. Thus, it will run through December 2, 2019.
