LEGAL ACTION REPORT

ACTION TAKEN:

A Quorum of the Civil Service Commission consisting of Chair Max Parks and Commissioners Marion Pickens and Malcom Pavey met on October 4 and 5, 2016, to hear the matter of Rudy Rodriguez. Commissioner Pickens made a motion to find that the Appellant knew or should have known that his conduct could lead to disciplinary action and that the appeal of Rudy Rodriguez be denied and find that the charge of dishonesty has not been established and is therefore unsupported, but that the remaining charges have been proved and established and therefore that the disciplinary action imposed upon him be affirmed for the reason that there was just cause for the discipline imposed. Commissioner Pavey seconded the motion. The motion was passed by a vote of 2 – 1 with Commissioner Parks dissenting.
