2. Approval of Legal Action Report/Minutes: March 4, 2019

It was moved by Commissioner Anderson, duly seconded and carried by a voice vote of 4 to 0 (Commissioners Perez and Sitzman absent/excused) to approve the Legal Action Report/Minutes of March 4, 2019.

3. Review Data and Develop Commission Recommendation

Discussion began with information provided by each Commission member who submitted a draft with their comments/rationale for the final recommendation.

Commissioner Anderson entertained the idea of using the rationale submitted by Chair Kimble over all the others that were submitted. He said Mr. Kimble's journalism background will help persuade voters.

Discussion ensued regarding the voter-approved bonds in the last 3 – 5 years.

Feedback was given by Commissioner Kelso regarding her opposition to support the placement of an issue on the 2019 General Election ballot recommending raises for the Mayor and Council Members.

The Recommendation was finalized based on the action taken by the Commission at their March 4, 2019 meeting to recommend an item be placed on the 2019 General Election ballot recommending an increase in the Mayor's salary to \$63,128 per year and an increase in Council Members' salaries to \$42,081.

Commission members present signed the Final Report and Recommendation.
