DaCosta reviews donation process through City of Tucson/Pima County and administrative directive guidelines. Donations checklist and locations have been provided and will be reviewed here.

Committee reviews donations paperwork presented for mural by Rachel Rios and Carlos Valenzuela. The location for proposed mural is at 86 E. Alameda Street. The committee clarifies with Rios that the mural will be painted to include areas including raised areas of the wall and will not be painted over light fixtures.

Lane Mandle, City Manager’s Office, explains that three murals total are being painted with funding through the Tohono O’odham Gaming Grants Program. The two murals today were selected for walls on public property.

Committee reviews donations paperwork presented for mural by Jessica Gonzales. The location for proposed mural is at 35 W. Alameda Street. The committee expresses concern about mural being broken up by windows or doors. Gonzales clarifies that the entirety of mural will be done on the larger space, with design elements of the mural added to the two smaller spaces to the right of the main surface.

Burstein reviews criteria for approving donations process for both murals.
