Currently, we are at the Gold level, the highest rating for a region in the USA. Available above the Gold level are Platinum and Diamond. The purpose of this subcommittee is to prepare the application that is due in February of 2020, and explore any changes over the next year that could potentially enhance SAFETY and RIDERSHIP numbers in Eastern Pima County.

Attention will be given to the five E's of Bicycle Friendly Community review.

*Enforcement:* Ensuring safe roads for all users

*Engineering:* Creating safe and convenient places to ride and park

*Education:* Giving people of all ages and abilities the skills and confidence to ride

*Encouragement:* Creating a strong bike culture that welcomes and celebrates bicycling

*Evaluation & Planning:* Planning for bicycling as a safe and viable transportation option
