



The **Tucson-Pima County Bicycle Advisory Committee** conducted a public meeting on April 10, 2019 at the City of Tucson Ward 6 Office, 3202 E 1st St Tucson, AZ

1. **Call to Order. Introductions and approval of March 2019 meeting minutes.**

Ryan Fagan called the meeting to order at 6:01 pm. 14 members in attendance.

A motion to approve the March meeting minutes with corrections was made by Daphne Hope and seconded by Paul Tilley. The motion passed with 13 in favor and one abstaining.

2. **Call to Public.**

Michael Barr, representing volunteers from the Pima County Sheriff's Auxiliary provided the committee with a brief update of recent Loop activity, including user etiquette issues and questions regarding e-bike use. Another Loop user also brought forward etiquette issues including the presence of unleashed dogs, abandoned shopping carts and motorized vehicles. This user additionally commented on loose gravel along roadsides and inquired about funding for street sweeping.

3. **Nominating Committee Check In and Officer Nominations.**

The nominating committee submitted the outcome of its poll to determine member interest in serving in one of the four TPCBAC officer capacities. Ryan followed up by asking if any of the committee members present would like to add their name as a candidate. The nominees have been recorded and voting will take place at the May TPCBAC meeting.

4. **Announcements, Updates From and Questions for Related Entities.**

- GABA – The bi-annual GABA Swap Meet will take place Sunday April 14, from 7 am until 1 pm on 7th Street between 4th and 6th Avenues.
- CASAz – They have produced new informational cards with telephone numbers and guidelines for reporting roadway and bike path hazards.
- LSA – No representative from Living Streets Alliance was present.
- PBAA – No representative from Perimeter Bicycling Association was present.
- Big Jump – No representative from Big Jump was present.
- U of A Cycling – The University of Arizona is hosting its Spring Fling event on the campus mall April 12 – 14, and U of A Cycling will provide a free bike valet. They

will also be participating in the Musselman Criterium April 13, from 7 am – 8 pm at the Musselman Honda Circuit located at 11800 S Harrison.

Prior to adjournment, Bob Webster noted that a representative from the Santa Cruz Valley Bicycle Advocate Committee of Green Valley would be presenting at the May TPCBAC meeting. Additionally, there will be a potluck scheduled at the beginning of next month's meeting to acknowledge the departures of current TPCBAC Chair Kylie Walzak and long-serving member David Bachman-Williams and to honor their service to the community.
