**CREATED BY:**

Mayor and Council Action, October 8, 1990 Study Session  
Administrative Directive, A.D. 7.01-1  
Ordinance 11599, Adopted December 4, 2018

**MEMBERSHIP / QUALIFICATIONS:**

Membership shall consist of 21 members who shall serve without compensation and are appointed as follows:

- 1) The Mayor and Council shall each appoint one member. (7 total)
- 2) The City Manager shall appoint one (1) member.
- 3) Tucson-Pima Arts Council shall appoint seven (7) members.
- 4) Pima County shall appoint six (6) members.

This Committee is a subcommittee of the Tucson-Pima Arts Council.

**FUNCTIONS:**

- 1) Develop the Public Art Plan, recommend changes to the Plan as necessary, and oversee its implementation.
- 2) Conduct a program of community outreach in support of the Public Art Program.
- 3) Select professionals in the visual arts and design fields to serve as jurors in the art selection process.
- 4) Gifts and Donations: Review and comment on gifts and donations in the areas of conservation/preservation expenses, placement, and appropriateness of inclusion into the Public Art Collection.
- 5) Conservation and Preservation: Conduct periodic surveys of the condition of the Public Art Collection.

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- 6) Coordinate the removal or relocation of artworks from the Public Art Collection. (The Public Art Committee shall recommend removal of artworks to the Arts Council.) If the Arts Council concurs, the recommendation shall be forwarded to the City Manager. The City Manager shall make a recommendation to the Mayor and Council, which has final authority in such matters.

### **QUORUM:**

A quorum shall consist of eleven (11) voting members of the Committee.

### **TERMS OF OFFICE:**

Terms of those Committee Members appointed by the Mayor and Council are coterminous with that of the appointing elected official. Other members shall be appointed for 4-year terms. Members of the Committee are eligible for reappointment but in no event may any individual serve more than a total of eight (8) consecutive years.

### **APPLICABILITY OF TUCSON CODE CHAPTER 10A, ARTICLE XIII:**

All provisions of TCC Chapter 10A, Article XIII are applicable. T.C. § 10A-134(c) Appointees, except for advisory members and members of the technical code committees named herein, may not serve on more than two (2) bodies at a time.

### **OPEN PUBLIC MEETING LAW REQUIREMENTS:**

This public body is defined as an advisory committee and must comply with all of the provisions of the Open Public Meeting Law. Minutes of the meetings are to be filed with the Tucson-Pima Arts Council.
