1. Call to Order. Roll Call and approval of previous meeting minutes.

Stacy Rodenberg called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. 19 members in attendance. (quorum met) New Pima County appointees were welcomed to the TPCBAC and members introduced themselves. Corrections to the September meeting minutes were noted and the Chair requested a motion to approve them.

Motion: A motion to approve the May meeting's minutes was made by Les Pierce, seconded by Paul Tilley and passed unanimously by voice vote.

2. Call to the Public.

Stacy Rodenberg made a call to the public in attendance for comments, none was brought forward.

3. Law Enforcement Staff Reports.

No representatives from law enforcement were present at the October meeting.

4. Steve Bohn, Tucson Bicycle Classic.

Steve Bohn, a founder of the Tucson Bicycle Classic, a USA cycling sanctioned stage race, presented information to TPCBAC members about the upcoming event and current volunteer opportunities.

5. Announcements, Updates and Questions for Related Entities.

- GABA, Wayne Cullop reported on GABA's work fixing and distributing bikes to local middle schools. He noted upcoming GABA events including the Mountain to Mountain ride, on November 3rd and the GABA Bike Swap on November 17.

- CASAz, Daphne Hope shared information on CASAz first annual Bike Summit, which is happening in conjunction with El Tour. The Bike Summit is scheduled for November 22, from 12:30 to 6:00 pm. Tickets are available on their website.
- Big Jump, Andy Bemis noted that community rides are scheduled the last Friday of the month and have had good attendance. Big Jump will be promoting rides in areas scheduled for Prop 407 improvements as well.
- U of A Cycling, Joey Iuliano shared that race officials are still being sought for upcoming events. The Spring 2020 event calendar has been completed.
