The Police and Fire Public Safety Personnel Retirement Local Boards are convened under Arizona Revised Statutes 38-847.

The Police and Fire Public Safety Personnel Retirement Local Boards held regular, joint, monthly meetings during 2019. The boards met in all months with a quorum of members. The purpose of the meetings is to provide for administration of the retirement system by determining all questions of eligibility and service credits, determining benefit amounts and the manner and time of payment of any benefit to members of the plan.

No special board meetings were required during 2019.

The Tucson Fire Public Safety Personnel Retirement Local Board held a mail ballot *special* election from August 16 to September 6, 2019 due to the resignation of Mr. Matt Dorner from the Tucson Fire Department. He vacated his board seat on June 17, 2019. His term was scheduled to run through June 30, 2022. The canvass of election results was provided at the October 2019 meeting. Mr. Jason Adler was elected to the Fire Board for the remainder of Mr. Dorner's term.



Mayor Regina Romero was elected to office on November 5, 2019 and began her term as Mayor for the City of Tucson on December 2, 2019. Under the Arizona Revised Statutes that govern the Public Safety Personnel Retirement System, as the new Mayor, she became the new Chairperson for the Police and Fire Public Safety Personnel Retirement Local Boards.
