**ENVIRONMENTAL ACCORDS/GREEN CITIES DECLARATION
AND SUSTAINABILITY COMMITTEE
(EA/GCDSC)**

CREATED BY:

Ordinance 10367, December 19, 2006

MEMBERS:

Seventeen (17) voting members, who shall serve without compensation.

QUORUM:

A quorum shall consist of nine (9) members of the Committee.

QUALIFICATIONS:

The Mayor and Council shall appoint members from recommendations made by the entities listed below. One member shall be selected from each of the following entities:

- (1) Alliance of Construction Trades
- (2) American Rainwater Catchment System Association
- (3) Center for Biological Diversity
- (4) Coalition for Sonoran Desert Protection
- (5) Development Center for Appropriate Technology
- (6) Environmental Education Exchange
- (7) Environment Justice Action Group
- (8) Natural Systems Solutions
- (9) Neighborhood Infill Coalition
- (10) Sonoran Institute
- (11) Southern Arizona Home Builders Association
- (12) The Nature Conservancy of Arizona
- (13) The Solar Institute
- (14) Tucson Audubon Society
- (15) Tucson Underground Contractors Association
- (16) Tucson-Pima County Metropolitan Energy Commission (provided that the member from this Commission cannot be a City appointee to the Energy Commission)
- (17) The Sierra Club

TERMS OF OFFICE:

Members shall serve four (4) year terms from the date of appointment.

EXEMPT FROM TCC 10A-134(c): No

FUNCTIONS:

Facilitate and monitor the City's progress on the Environmental Accords/Green Cities Declaration and the Kyoto Treaty and advise Mayor and Council on ways to best meet the goals set out in those documents. The EA/GCDSC shall from time to time report to the Mayor and Council regarding its recommendations on the methods to achieve these goals.

LIMITATIONS:

Neither the Task Force nor any member thereof may incur governmental expenses without prior authorization of the Mayor and Council nor may they obligate the City in any form.

OPEN PUBLIC MEETING LAW REQUIREMENTS:

This public body is defined as an advisory committee and must comply with all of the provisions of the Open Public Meeting Law.
