Mission Statement of the Commission: *To improve access to and delivery of addiction, treatment, and prevention programs in Tucson and Pima County and in partnership with city and county governments in order to reduce the social, financial, and health consequences of addiction and other substance use disorders.*

The Pima County-City of Tucson Commission on Addiction Prevention and Treatment membership was ratified by the Tucson Mayor and Council and the Pima County Board of Supervisors on October 22, 2001 to serve rural, suburban, and urban Pima County (9,184 square miles). The Commission's purpose is to provide advice and make recommendations with respect to the social, financial, and health consequence of addiction in Pima County. The Commission's primary goal is to create a functional system that reduces substance abuse in our community.

The Commission has 19 voting members, and 8 ex-officio members representing business, government, recovery groups, and prevention providers. Monthly meetings are subject to Open Meeting Laws. The five working Committees of the Commission are **the Task Force to Reduce Underage Drinking, the Community Prevention Coalition, Policy Committee, Community Education Committee, and the Nominating Committee.**
