BOARDS, COMMITTEES & COMMISSIONS

BOARD OF APPEALS

CREATED BY:

Tucson Code, § 6-12 et. Seq.

MEMBERS:

Seven members appointed by the Mayor and Council. The members shall recommend an individual to serve as the representative of the consuming public.

QUORUM:

Four members of the Board present at a meeting constitute a quorum.

QUALIFICATIONS:

An architect duly licensed in the State of Arizona.

A professional engineer duly licensed in the State of Arizona.

A general contractor duly licensed in the State of Arizona.

A person representing the consuming public.

A person engaged in the electrical, mechanical or plumbing trade.

Two persons who may be engaged in the construction and design industry.

TERMS OF OFFICE:

4-year terms staggered so that at least one but no more than two terms expire at the end of each calendar year (December 31st).

EXEMPT FROM TCC 10A-134: No

FUNCTIONS:

To determine the suitability of alternate materials or alternate types or methods of construction and of installation of building service equipment under the provisions of the building safety administrative code, building, electrical, fire, light pollution, mechanical, plumbing, solar system and spa/pool codes of the City, and to provide for reasonable interpretations of the provisions of such codes and the address numbering and dangerous building codes.

OPEN PUBLIC MEETING LAW REQUIREMENTS:

This public body must comply with all provisions of the Open Meeting Law, including that a record of all meetings be maintained.

BCC TERMINATION REQUIREMENTS: This is an on-going board.
