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**CORE TAX AND PERMANENT OVERRIDE  
REVIEW COMMITTEE (CTPORC)**

**CREATED BY:**

Resolution 21562, adopted May 25, 2010

**MEMBERSHIP / QUALIFICATIONS:**

Membership shall consist of fourteen (14) members who shall serve without compensation; shall represent diverse sectors of the community such as neighborhoods, non-profit organizations, major employers, small businesses, and education; and shall be residents of the City of Tucson, or have their primary business address located in the City of Tucson, or both.

The Mayor and each Council member shall appoint two (2) members each.

The Committee shall have two (2) co-chairpersons.

The Committee may form subcommittees as necessary to fulfill its duties and functions.

**FUNCTIONS:**

The Committee shall advise the Mayor and Council on the following matters:

- a. Whether, and if so, how best to take a sales tax increase to voters on the November 2, 2010, ballot to address the structural deficit in the general fund.
- b. If a sales tax increase is to be proposed, the tax increase amount.
- c. How sales tax revenues would be programmed based on a successful ballot measure.
- d. Whether to place a permanent expenditure base adjustment (override) on the November 2, 2010, ballot.

## **Core Tax and Permanent Override Review Committee**

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- e. Recommended ballot language for any proposed sales tax increase or permanent expenditure base adjustment.
- f. Alternative options if a tax increase is not placed on the ballot or is not approved by the voters.

### **QUORUM:**

A quorum shall consist of eight (8) members.

### **TERMS OF OFFICE:**

Terms are consistent with the Committee itself, each member shall serve until September 1, 2010, at which time the Committee will terminate.

### **APPLICABILITY OF TUCSON CODE CHAPTER 10A, ARTICLE XIII:**

- Provisions of TCC § 10A-134(c) – Members of the Committee may serve concurrently on other City boards, committees and commissions
- Provisions of TCC § 10A-139(b) are not applicable. The Committee shall make its recommendations to the Mayor and Council regarding matters (a)-(e) above by report filed with the City Clerk no later than July 7, 2010 and regarding matter (f) above by report filed with the City Clerk no later than September 1, 2010.
- Provisions of TCC § 10-A-139(b)(5) is not applicable – no annual report is required.
- All other provisions of TCC § 10A, Article XIII (T.C. §§ 10A-133 through 10A-139 inclusive) are applicable.

### **OPEN PUBLIC MEETING LAW REQUIREMENTS:**

This public body is defined as an advisory committee and must comply with all of the provisions of the Open Public Meeting Law.
