



Pyrotechnics Permit Requirements

A permit application packet must be submitted to the Fire Prevention office no later than thirty (30) days prior to the scheduled display. In that packet you must include the following items:

1. A completed **Application for Display of 1.4 Pyrotechnics**.
2. A copy of a state issued photo ID (front and back) of the shooter(s) conducting the display.
3. A copy of the **Certificate of Liability Insurance** for a minimum of three million dollars with the City of Tucson listed as additional insured, with a Waiver of Subrogation.
4. A copy of a **Shooter Certification Card** issued by the Tucson Fire Department or by an approved regulating agency.
5. A detailed **Site Plan** depicting the exact placement of pyrotechnics to be used as well as set back distances to the audience, performers and/or stage props, and combustible material.
6. A **product listing and performance specifications** of pyrotechnics to be used including the number, type and burn time.
7. An **MSDS** for each type of pyrotechnic material to be used.
8. A manufacturer statement that the material is designed and tested for indoor use.
9. A copy of any applicable **ATF license/permit**.
10. A **Safety Plan**.

It is at the discretion of the Tucson Fire Department to verify the documentation provided in the permit application packet for compliance. Incomplete packets or packets submitted late may be cause for denial of a permit.
