

# Permit Requirements – Fireworks

**A permit application packet must be submitted to the Fire Prevention office no later than thirty (30) days prior to the scheduled display. In that packet you must include the following items:**

1. A completed **Application for Display of 1.3 Fireworks**.
2. A copy of a state issued photo ID (front and back) of the shooter(s) conducting the display.
3. A copy of the **Certificate of Liability Insurance** for a minimum of one million dollars with the City of Tucson listed as additional insured.
4. A copy of a **Shooters Certification Card** issued by the Tucson Fire Department.
5. A detailed **Site Plan** depicting the exact placement of fireworks to be used as well as set back distances to the audience, structures, overhead lines or any type of combustible material, fall out area, roadways and access points.
6. A **product listing** of fireworks to be used including the number, size and type.
7. An **MSDS** for each type of pyrotechnic material to be used.

**It is at the discretion of the Tucson Fire Department to verify the documentation provided in the permit application packet for compliance. Incomplete packets or packets submitted late may be cause for denial of a permit.**
