

TUCSON WARD 4 SOLAR 10 YEAR ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION

FRIDAY JUNE 19, 2009 2-5 PM

Please join Councilmember Shirley Scott, the staff of the Clements Recreation and Fitness Center, and the City of Tucson Energy and Solar Office in celebrating 10 years of solar installations on City of Tucson facilities. The event will take place Friday June 19 from 2-5 pm at the Clements Regional Center/Ward 4 offices located at 8123 E. Poinciana, Tucson, off Pantano near Irvington Rd.

Information on solar energy in general, details of the photovoltaic system installed on the Ward 4 building, and updates on City solar projects will be presented. Get your questions about solar energy answered and view two City of Tucson solar sites and a third at nearby Pima Community College East Campus.

The solar installation on Ward 4 was installed in June, 1999 as the first PV installation on City of Tucson facilities and is rated at 7.2 kW DC. This week it will be joined by the City's newest photovoltaic project, the 473 kW DC tracker system at the Public Safety Training Academy.

In addition to solar information, free lemonade, popcorn and hot dogs will be available at the Clements Recreation Center.
