

Partnership Agreement Promise Zone

WHEREAS, the City of Tucson, City of South Tucson, and Pima County have come together to collaborate and to submit an application for U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Promise Zone designation; and

WHEREAS, the partners have agreed to enter into a collaborative agreement in which the City of Tucson will be the lead agency and named applicant and the other agencies will be partners in this application; and

WHEREAS, the partners herein desire to enter into a Partnership Agreement setting forth the implementation plan;

WHEREAS, the approved is to be submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development on November 21, 2014; and

WHEREAS, upon receipt of Promise Zone designation, all entities will enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA):

Summary and Plan. The entities outlined in this Partnership Agreement have agreed to collaborate and engage in a 10-year collaborative revitalization effort to create jobs, increase economic activity, improve educational opportunities, reduce violent and serious crime in the Promise Zone.

The entities outlined in this Partnership Agreement have agreed to implement specific activities in relation to one or more Promise Zone goals. The entities have also agreed to commit financial and non-financial resources, to participate in partner meetings, to report activities and outcomes in the Promise Zone, and to engage residents in the planning, design, and implementation of Promise Zone activities. Specific funding commitments are not contingent upon Promise Zone designation. The initial financial commitment to the Promise Zone is outlined in the letter of commitment from each of the partners and in the Promise Zone application. Each partner is committed the sharing of Promise Zone activities and to compiling and maintaining Promise Zone data.

The lead agency will execute a Promise Zone Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) and be responsible to HUD for fulfilling the responsibilities of the Promise Zone designation. These responsibilities will include organizing and/or coordinating activities pursuant to the plan proposed in the designated community's application and administering any funding or other benefits that designation may confer in the future to designated Promise Zones. The lead agency will also be responsible for tracking outcomes, periodically reporting to the participating federal agencies, and participating in evaluation activities as requested by federal agencies. The

lead agency will provide certification to other organizations applying for grants and other benefits that, if received, would help to advance the Promise Zone Plan.

If granted a Promise Zone designation, the Intergovernmental Agreement will outline key responsibilities for each partner.

Due to legal requirements, PZ Implementation Partners agreed to enter into a preliminary partnership agreement in lieu of a Memorandum of Understanding. Both the City of Tucson Council and Pima County Board of Supervisors approved the PZ Application and preliminary partnership agreement. The City of South Tucson will formally approve the preliminary partnership agreement at the December 2, 2014 City Council meeting. Upon PZ designation, the jurisdictions will enter into an inter-governmental agreement as provided for in Arizona statute. The inter-governmental agreement will include the roles and activities of each jurisdiction, and provide remedies for non-performance.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TUCSON, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Director of the City of Tucson Community Services Department or designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute various U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) forms, documents, budgets, certifications, and related documents.



SECTION 3. The various City officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this resolution.


SECTION 4. WHEREAS, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the City of Tucson that this resolution become immediately


