

## **Public Facilities Request for Proposals FY 2015 – Proposal Summaries**

**Total available Funding: \$741,310 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) City of Tucson entitlement funds through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)**

### **PROJECT ONE**

Department of Transportation - Nogales Highway/Thoroughbred Street HAWK

Location: Approx. 5100 S. Nogales Highway

Census Tract 38.02/Ward 5

CDBG Funding Request: \$200,000

Description: Install a pedestrian traffic signal to serve users of the El Pueblo Community Center and Rudy Garcia Park. This project will provide for a safe crossing of Nogales Highway, to serve users of the El Pueblo Community Center and Rudy Garcia Park. Immediately west of the El Pueblo Community Center is the Laos Transit Center.

### **PROJECT TWO**

Transportation Department - Nogales Highway/Olive Street HAWK

Location: Approx. 5300 S. Nogales Highway

Census Tract 38.02/Ward 5

CDBG Funding Request: \$200,000

Description: Install a pedestrian traffic signal to allow pedestrians to safely cross Nogales Highway, including students from several surrounding schools. This project will provide for a safe crossing of Nogales Highway, to serve users of the El Pueblo Community Center, Rudy Garcia Park, Apollo Middle School, Liberty Elementary School, and several charter schools. Immediately west of the El Pueblo Community Center is the Laos Transit Center.

### **PROJECT THREE**

Parks & Recreation Department - Estevan Park Improvements

Location: 1001 N. Main

Census Tract 3/Ward 1

CDBG Funding Request: \$741,000

Description: Design, permit and install a football/rugby field lighting system, scoreboard, comfort station (rest room), bleacher shade structures, and ADA accessibility improvements to include parking, pedestrian circulation and assembly seating. The project will provide additional and expanded recreational opportunities for youth and adults in the neighborhood and city, as well as improved facilities for the disabled.
