## Pool Membership

Our pool memberships are down and our costs are going up. Since there is very little that we can do to lower our costs, we have to focus on ways to increase revenue, 80% of which comes from memberships. The two ways to increase our membership revenues are to increase the membership fees (which none of us want), or increase the number of members. To help drive up our memberships, the board has authorized a **\$25 discount** for first time pool members (NEVER been a member before) along with a **\$25 credit** (applied to next year's membership) to any pool member who brings in a new member. Please encourage your friends and neighbors to join the pool, and if you have been thinking about joining, there's never been a better time to join than right now.
