Still way too many ENDLESSLY BARKING DOGS

Please **be a good neighbor** and do something about it. Leave a note on the door of "barky's" owner. If you have approached your neighbor to politely let them know there is a problem and there is no resolving of the continual barking, then it's time to call the police and file a complaint. If the barking doesn't stop, call again. Insist that a citation be issued if the barking is chronic. Talk to your neighbors to see if they have called as well. A good well-trained dog will quit barking after a disturbance is over. Be kind to your neighbors! And don't forget to take a plastic bag to pick up your dog's poop when you walk them. Thank you!

Helpful Hint: When you put out your trash or recycling, locate the containers somewhere that is NOT in front of or close to your driveway. The reason to push them farther away is that the garbage trucks slam on their brakes, the tires lock, and it rips holes in the asphalt where the wheels lock. Therefore, at the base of your driveway you'll see deep holes where the asphalt has been torn out!

If you already have trenches there, call the City and ask that they fix them!
