The City of Tucson wishes to inform the public that it is seeking **community input** for proposed Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) public facility projects located within the following census tracts: 1, 3 and 38.02. A map of those areas, as well as further information, can be found at the City of Tucson, Housing and Community Development web site at <http://www.tucsonaz.gov/hcd/>. Examples of public facility projects that can be carried out with CDBG funds include: acquisition of land or buildings, installation of a public facility e.g. a park or shelter for homeless persons, paved road, sewer system, street light, ADA improvements, property rehabilitation, removal of architectural barriers, historic preservation, renovation of closed buildings and blight remediation.
