Don't put the Brush & Bulky out too soon!

If you have lots of trash, call (520) 647-9958 and we'll try to arrange for someone to help you. Otherwise, move all your trash to the curb in late April.

Curbs & Alleys

All residents are to maintain curbs and alleys. We are all responsible for keeping these free of litter and trash. If on a corner, both curbs must be maintained so drivers can see oncoming traffic at the corner. It is a violation of the City Code to dump trash, cuttings, and junk in the alley. "Curb" means the whole area out to the edge of the pavement.

TEAM UP CLEAN UP

If you and your neighbors would like to clean-up your neighborhood, the Environmental Services Department (ES) of the City of Tucson can help.

ES will provide roll-off containers (dumpsters) for your use and will haul away the debris at no cost.
