

BMX Bike Track

Larry Robinson, Division Manger, Pima County Regional Flood Control District sent us an email May 15th that read in part: "Please find attached the BMX Park plan that Pima County Risk Management has approved.

"As noted on the plan, Pima County will provide additional improvements in the form of post and cable, a hose bib/ water source for BMX ramp compaction and dust control, and rules sign."



Most of the work will be completed on the BMX Bike Track by the end of the May.
