

Starnet Interactive Map has detailed info on area crime
Go online to go.azstarnet.com/crime and check out StarNet's interactive crime map. Based on Tucson police database of calls for service, the map displays approximate locations of recent reports of crime or other incidents, such as reports of suspicious activity. The map is updated at about 7:30 each morning to add the previous day's incidents. You'll also find tips on how to help police with information and how to avoid becoming a victim.
