IMPROVEMENTS COMING SOON TO MITCHELL PARK

JOIN US FOR SOME FUN EVENTS!!!

In partnership with the Mountain and 1st Ave Neighborhood Association, Watershed Management Group will lead a two-day workshop series to implement green infrastructure features (such as trees, shrubs, water-harvesting basins, boulders) within Mitchell Park. Volunteers will have the opportunity to help renovate a portion of the park, creating basins to passively harvest rainwater and storm water, supporting the creation of improved wildlife habitat within the park. This project is funded by a grant from the Conserve to Enhance Program. This workshop series will be led by WMG instructor and landscape architect James DeRoussel, who will provide a hands-on education in green infrastructure, passive water harvesting systems and native landscape practices. Work will be completed over the course of two public workshops on Saturday, December 7 from 8:30 am - 12:30 pm. and December 14, 2013 from 8:30 am - 12:30 pm. Advanced sign-up is required for each workshop and space is limited.
