Beginning February 14, 2013, Request for Proposals (RFP) for the following areas will be solicited:


Outreach, Emergency Shelter Support, Rapid Rehousing and Prevention

PUBLIC NOTICE: Each year the City of Tucson is required by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to update the Consolidated Plan (FY 2011-2015) and develop an Annual Plan. The Annual Plan outlines the needs, priorities and strategies for housing, supportive services, and community development programs. The Plan also establishes policies and goals for the City, and serves as the local government's application for annual entitlement funding for the following federal programs: Community Development Block Grant (CDBG); HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME); Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) and the Housing for People with Aids program (HOPWA). FY 2013 funding is estimated to be: CDBG \$5,208,000; HOME \$3,528,000; ESG \$578,567 and HOPWA \$420,497.

A public hearing regarding the Annual Plan for FY 2013 will be held in April 2013. The time and place will be noticed separately.
