

## WHAT'S IN SWANWAY PARK NEIGHBORHOOD

Swanway Park Neighborhood's boundaries are Swan Road on the West, Rosemont Boulevard the East, Speedway Boulevard on the North and Fifth Street on the South.

We have a nice park the neighborhood is named after—Swan Way Park which is located at First Street and Arcadia.

There are 3 churches in our neighborhood—Berean Bible Church on Fourth Street, Faith

Temple Apostolic Church on Baker Street, and United Fellowship Church on Hawthorne Street.

We are bisected by Arcadia Wash which runs from South to North and is home to lots of interesting wildlife, including coyotes.

Swanway Park Neighborhood is the home of over 75 businesses including the ones on the corners of the neighborhood

boundaries: Circle K at Speedway and Swan, Bambi at Speedway and Rosemont, Fifth Street Deli and Market at Fifth and Rosemont and Vision Quest at Fifth and Swan. Besides offices, other businesses include veterinarians, car repair shops, antique shops and restaurants.
